Dean,

It was a pleasure to speak with you as well. I just spoke with my client, and he is willing to extend the deadline to Monday (Dec. 6th), but no further. Wade pointed out that Dr. Cartinhour, Mr. Kearney, et al. were asking the DC court as recently as last week to hold him in contempt, put him in jail, etc. unless he dropped the SDNY case.

The DC court told Dr. Cartinhour & Mr. Kearney more than once that she was not going to interfere w/ the NY case, and Wade feels that Dr. Cartinhour unreasonably waited until the last minute to retain counsel, etc. I do not know if you have spoken with Dr. Cartinhour yet, but I doubt he is aware of much of what Mr. Kearney has been doing.

Wade made some very reasonable settlement offers in the DC case (including settlement of the NY claims), but Mr. Kearney countered with a proposal to dismiss all claims against all NY defendants, i.e., settlement was conditioned on the dismissal of claims against Mr. Kearney. I'd be surprised if Dr. Cartinhour was aware of this. In any event, I'm glad you're on the case now, because Wade is still willing to entertain settlement discussions directly w/ Dr. Cartinhour. Please let me know if Dr. Cartinhour is interested. Thanks.
