Pursuant to FRAP Rule 28(j), the Appellant submits this letter regarding *Ligon v. City of New York*, Nos.13-3123 and 13-3088, 2013_WL_5835441 (2d Cir. Oct. 31, 2013); and *In re Reassignment of Cases*, Nos.13-3123 and 13-3088, 2013_WL_998139 (2d Cir. Nov. 13, 2013). Both decisions issued after briefing was completed.

In the foregoing cases, as in the case before the Court, a district judge manipulated the case assignment system in order to assign a case to herself. The Second Circuit sharply criticized that practice and ordered reassignment on remand.
