Dear Requester:

This letter is a final response to your 28 April, 2021 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for all documents, records, communications or reports that were implicitly or explicitly referenced by Kash Patel in the February 25, 2021 interview, e.g., all House Intelligence Committee reports and memoranda regarding the "Russian collusion" matter. We processed your request in accordance with the FOIA (5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended, and the CIA Information Act, 50 U.S.C. § 3141, as amended).

We did not locate any records responsive to your request. Although our searches were reasonably calculated to uncover all relevant records, and it is highly unlikely that repeating those searches would change the result, you nevertheless have the legal right to appeal the finding of no records responsive to your request.

As the CIA Information and Privacy Coordinator, I am the CIA official responsible for this determination. You have the right to appeal this response to the Agency Release Panel, in my care, within 90 days from the date of this letter. Please explain the basis for your appeal.

Please be advised that you may also seek dispute-resolution services from the CIA FOIA Public Liaison or from the Office of Government Information Services (OGIS) of the National Archives and Records Administration. OGIS offers mediation services to help resolve disputes between FOIA requesters and Federal agencies
