Members of the Grand Jury:

I have enclosed for your consideration a letter to District Attorney Greg Willis. As set forth in that letter, I believe he has a serious conflict of interest as a result of his business relationships with Attorney General Ken Paxton. I hope you will ask questions about Eldorado-Collin, L.P. and its real estate ventures, because the taxpayers have a right to know whether local officials enriched themselves at the expense of the taxpayers. Not later than Monday, I will post some of the relevant documents on my blog, www.LawFlog.com, as well as a link to the May 4, 2014 *Dallas Morning News* article.

After sending my earlier letter, I realized that the three-year limitations period on Mr. Paxton's felony securities violation will lapse some time in 2015 (and may have lapsed already). Since time is of the essence in this matter, I requested the names of all grand jurors from the district clerk's office in order to send this letter to some of your home addresses.

You may recall that the Travis County District Attorney's Office announced in January that it was forwarding the results of its investigation to the district attorneys in Collin County and Dallas County. If you receive this letter at your home address, I hope you will go to the DA's office before the next grand jury meeting and demand to see the Travis County investigation report. Incidentally, I am sending copies of this correspondence and my earlier correspondence to the FBI and federal prosecutors.
