Thank you for taking the time to speak to me on May 11, 2016, regarding this lawsuit. During that call, you requested that the State Bar Defendants (Judge Lucy Armendariz, Robert Hawley, Craig Holden, and the State Bar of California) refer certain matters to the California Attorney General and in exchange, you would dismiss this pending action. The State Bar Defendants reject your settlement offer and intend to file a motion to strike pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure 425.16 and a demurrer, on or before the current stipulated date of June 27, 2016.

During our conversation, you indicated that should the State Bar Defendants reject your settlement offer, you would seek to amend your complaint prior to the filing of any motions before the court. The State Bar Defendants do not object to such an amendment and are willing to meet and confer to agree on a satisfactory deadline for the filing of an amended complaint.
