Re: Complaint of Attorney Misconduct

To Whom It May Concern:

Pursuant to Fed. R. App. P. 46(b)(1)(B), I wish to file misconduct complaints against attorneys Hillary Rodham Clinton of 120 West 45th Street, Suite 2700, New York, NY 10036 and David E. Kendall of Williams & Connolly LLP, 725 12th Street NW, Washington DC 20005-3901. That subsection permits the Court to suspend or disbar an attorney who "is guilty of conduct unbecoming a member of the court's bar."

I have enclosed a September 1, 2016 bar grievance that I filed against Mrs. Clinton with the Arkansas State Bar, and I incorporate that grievance and its exhibits by reference as if fully set forth herein. In a telephone conversation this morning, Court Clerk Michael E. Gans informed me that the Court has not initiated any proceedings under that subsection in the 35 years that he has worked for the Court. I would note, however, that other federal circuit courts, including the Second and D.C. Circuits, have standing grievance committees. *See, e.g.,* [http://www.ca2.uscourts.gov/clerk/attorneys/attorney\\_discipline.html](http://www.ca2.uscourts.gov/clerk/attorneys/attorney_discipline.html).

I believe the Court should exercise jurisdiction over this matter because the Eighth Circuit is the only court where Mrs. Clinton's license is currently active (she appears to have been suspended from the Arkansas bar for failure to comply with continuing legal education requirements). Likewise, it is the only court whose bar includes both Mrs. Clinton and Mr. Kendall as members. Accordingly, I ask that you initiate proceedings to determine whether Mrs. Clinton and Mr. Kendall should be suspended or disbarred.
