Re: Complaint of Attorney Misconduct

Chief Judge Miller:

On September 1, 2016, I mailed a complaint of attorney misconduct against Hillary Rodham Clinton to the clerk's office. With this letter I am including copies of that complaint as well as a follow-up letter. I learned this morning that the clerk's office returned the complaint to me because Mrs. Clinton is an inactive member of the Court's bar.

It is my understanding that Mrs. Clinton is inactive only because she did not take continuing legal education courses as required by the Arkansas Bar, and she is eligible for reinstatement upon taking those courses. Given the evidence that Mrs. Clinton violated both federal criminal statutes and the rules of the profession, I do not believe that she should have the option of reinstatement. For that reason, I ask that you initiate an investigation to determine whether she should be permanently disbarred.

I am copying this letter to Chief Judge William Jay Riley because I filed an analogous complaint against Mrs. Clinton with the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Eighth Circuit. Mrs. Clinton is still an active member of that bar, and I thought perhaps the two courts might wish to handle the matter jointly.
