Members of the Board:

I have enclosed a copy of a letter that I sent to Disciplinary Counsel Wallace E. Shipp, Jr. regarding three cases that were dismissed by his deputy, Elizabeth Herman. For the reasons set forth in that letter, I believe the Office of Disciplinary Counsel (“ODC”) is in violation of D.C. Bar Rule XI(6)(a)(2), and I will likely seek mandamus relief if the problem is not corrected.

I provided the ODC with evidence that attorneys David Kendall, Cheryl Mills, and Heather Samuelson destroyed evidence while representing Hillary Clinton, but it seems Ms. Herman is more interested in protecting her party's Presidential candidate. In addition to the duties imposed on ODC, D.C. Bar Rule XI(4)(e) imposes a separate duty on the board to “consider and investigate any alleged ground for discipline or alleged incapacity of any attorney called to its attention, or upon its own motion, and to take such action with respect thereto as shall be appropriate to effect the purposes of this rule.” I therefore request that you initiate an investigation of Mr. Kendall, Ms. Mills, and Ms. Samuelson, or direct ODC to initiate such an investigation.
