The TABC hosted the NCSLA 2016 SOUTHERN/NORTHERN REGIONAL CONFERENCE, September 25-28, 2016 at the Radisson Hotel and Suites, Austin, Texas and while doing so the TABC also hosted a Hospitality Suite that included the serving or making available alcoholic beverages to paying conference attendees. The below is taken directly from the event flyer.

“As your conference host, TABC is here to show you what we love about Austin. We will host a conference with.....

A Saloon (hospitality suite) available for fun and networking.”

The Executive director of the TABC allowed the sale/service of alcoholic beverages at the TABC hosted NCSLA Conference while the NCLSA was charging admission to the conference and the admission included alcoholic beverage sold or served inside the TABC hosted hospitality suite. The alcoholic beverages were restricted only to paying conference attendees. TABC has advised that there is no record of an alcohol license or permit being issued for this event.
