My sector was conducting an undercover op in Addison and North Dallas. On our way to our last location Villa Grill in Addison on 7-23-26 at about 1:30, my, Partner [REDACTED] and I were at a stop light in the intersection of Belt line and Preston. On outer right turning lane a Dark BMW drove on the inner turning lane pulled up next to us and mouthed oh you police; rolled down his window turned up his music and began dancing and throwing hand signs.

Another vehicle pulled up on our right side the lane to go straight and looked over the the BMW inched up about 2 feet and looked at the driver of the BMW the driver of the BMW inched up as well and both began eyeing each other, at which time the driver of the blk chevy impala opened his door stepped out and shot 3 times at the BMW.

As he targeted the BMW the Driver of the BMW sped off going north on Belt line and the other car Impala went south on Beltline. The driver of the Impala sped off Agent [REDACTED] followed the Impala and we followed after them. We lost the vehicle.

During this, I contacted Addison PD advised them of shots fired and our location Dispatch advised we were in the city of Dallas and transferred my call to Dallas Dispatch. I identified myself and advised them of the shooting and descriptions of cars and drivers.

Nobody was hurt our car was not hit. I cancelled the last target of our op and debriefed with the Agents at Addison PD. DPD officer met us there and took our information. Officer La Pietra # 10252 Information #176723 2016.

I contacted Lt Walker and advised her of the incident. We did not active target anyone but Padgett and I did have our handguns out of our holsters for our safety.

I'm proud of the way my guys handled the situation. We or shall I say I was a little shaken. Very close call. Dallas PD said they had shots fired calls before our incident. Probably the same two suspects shooting at each other.

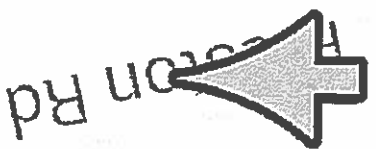

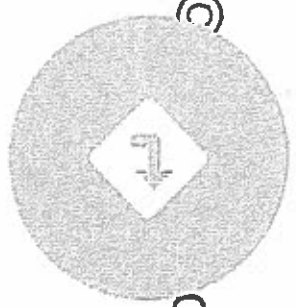

Narrative Information

REPORTING PERSON [REDACTED] AN OFFICER WITH TEXAS ALCOHOL BEVERAGE COMMISSION. STATES HE WAS N/B ON PRESTON ROAD IN THE MIDDLE LANE. RP AND PULLED UP NEXT TO A BLACK BMW IN THE LEFT TURNING LANE. BOTH VEHICLE ARE STOPPED AT THE TRAFFIC LIGHT AT PRESTON ROAD AND BELTLINE ROAD. BLACK MALE IN THE BMW STATED TO REPORTING PERSON "OH YOU ARE A COP" AND PROCEEDED TO SHOW GANGS SIGNS. A BLACK MALE IN AN OLDER CHEVROLET IMPALA WITH AN AIR FIN ON THE REAR, PULLED UP NEXT TO REPORTING PERSON IN THE RIGHT LANE. BLACK MALE IN THE IMPALA OPENED THE DRIVERS SIDE DOOR AND FIRED SHOTS AT THE BLACK MALE IN THE BMW. BOTH DRIVERS FLED THE LOCATION IN OPPOSITE LOCATION. NO INJURIES REPORTED.
