Dear Open Records Division:

The Department of Public Safety received the above-referenced request for information from Ty Clevenger on February 13, 2019. We believe some or all of the requested information is excepted from required public disclosure pursuant to section 552.103 of the Government Code. Accordingly, we are requesting a ruling regarding the release of these records.

The Department believes the records responsive to this request are excepted from required disclosure pursuant to section 552.103(a) of the Government Code, which excepts "information relating to litigation of a civil or criminal nature to which the state or a political subdivision is or may be a party or to which an officer or employee of the state or a political subdivision, as a consequence of the person's office or employment, is or may be a party." In Attorney General Decision ORD No. 638, your office held that a governmental entity's burden under this exception is two-pronged. First, the government entity must show that litigation is reasonably anticipated. Second, it must show that the requested information relates to that litigation.

First, the subject of this request has indicated in his own requests for public information that related records should be maintained by the Department for future legal action. (see DPS PIR # 19-0506). In addition, recent court filings indicate that the subject of this request will be called by the requestor as a witness in related litigation brought against the Department. Therefore, the Department believes the first prong of the test has clearly been met. Second, the information requested is inescapably related to the litigation. All of the information responsive to this request directly relates to the lawsuit, which alleges in part that select personnel in the Office of Inspector General are being driven out to effectuate an environment of "corruption and cronyism". The same allegations are made against the Department as a whole. Therefore, the Department believes it has

met both prongs of the test, and the requested information is excepted from required public inspection pursuant to section 552.103.
