When we spoke several weeks ago, I asked you to return my clients' computers now that the FBI has closed its investigation. I have not heard back from you and I ask that you contact me at your earliest convenience.

As set forth in our letter agreements of June 10, 2016 and as the parties agreed.

The Device is being provided to the Federal Bureau of Investigation ("FBI") solely for the purposes of this Department of Justice investigation, and for the Department's use in connection with the investigation. In voluntarily providing the Device, Cheryl Mills does not relinquish ownership or control over the Device, except for the FBI's limited investigative use as specified by this agreement. The FBI does not assert custody and control over the Device or its contents for any other purpose, including any requests made pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552.

Based on this agreement, there is no basis for the FBI to refuse to return my clients' property. The Government explicitly agreed that the FBI would not assert custody and control of the devices in the face of Freedom of Information Act requests.

Finally, we understand that during the investigation, the FBI found no classified information on the computers. Thus the return of the computers should not be delayed.

Dear Mr. Baker.

Recent media stories are reporting that the FBI intends to publicly release the interview notes of former Secretary Clinton as well as "other people interviewed during the course of the investigation." While it is unclear whose interview notes these media stories refer to exactly, I am writing about the possible public release of the interview notes of my clients: Cheryl Mills, Heather Samuelson, and Jake Sullivan.

My clients—each a private citizen at the time of his or her interview—voluntarily agreed to meet with the DOJ and FBI to aid in the investigation's fact finding. In discussions prior to the interviews, the government made representations to us that the contents of those interviews would be shared only among the investigative team. Had my clients and I thought that the agents' notes and impressions from those interviews—contained in the 302 forms—would later be released to the public, we would have asked for the interviews to be transcribed.

I object to any public release of the 302 forms of my clients' interviews as I strongly believe it vitiates the process to which we agreed and is contrary to the Bureau's practice. I would also like to understand the process by which the FBI has decided to single out certain individuals' 302s for release while maintaining the confidentiality of others.

I look forward to the opportunity to discuss this matter with you and the DOJ.
